Exceptional Louis XIII mantelpiece with sculpted trumeau in stone

Opulent and elegant, this fireplace is inspired by the classic Louis XIII French mantelpieces (17th Century). It is carved by hand in a natural limestone from Provence, the stone of "Estaillades". It features 2 straight and slender jambs decorated with a large molding that continues on the lower part of the lintel thus surrounding the hearth, 2 finely indented cornices (one on top of the trumeau and one on top of the lintel), and a trumeau beautifully hand-sculpted with floral decorations. Hand-crafted in Provence.
